Long-term health effects of early menopause. Early menopause (EM)/premature ovarian insufficiency (POI) leads to the early loss of oestrogen, which may negatively affect bone, cardiovascular, and cognitive health over the long term. Long-Term Health Consequences . Traumatic events can affect how a child's brain develops and that can have lifelong consequences. A study published in 2015 showed that the more adverse childhood experiences a person has, the higher their risk of health and wellness problems later in life.

The Effects of Childhood Trauma

Childhood stunting is related to long term consequences in two ways: • as a direct cause of short adult height and suboptimal function later in life and • as a key marker of the underlying processes in early life that lead to poor growth and other adverse outcomes.

Feeding and digestive problems: Premature infants often cannot drink from the breast or a bottle at birth, and may be fed with IV fluids or through a tube in the nose or mouth for several weeks. These early feeding challenges can cause long-term feeding difficulties, including food refusal and slow growth.

Long-Term Impact of Being Born Premature

Epigenetic changes in early life can cause long-term consequences in energy homeostasis and increase the risk of obesity in adulthood (Lillycrop and Burdge, 2011). Hence, the expression of some histone deacetylases (Hdac) was also determined and we observed that Hdac3 and Hdac5 mRNA levels were suppressed in the hypothalamus of LepR^{Null} mice and were not normalized after LepR reactivation (Figure 3G).

One of the drivers of such long-lasting effects might be the impact of early-life parameters on an individual ' s behavioral phenotype (Stamps and Groothuis 2010).
