Type 1 diabetes occurs because the insulin-producing cells of the pancreas (beta cells) are damaged. In Type 1 diabetes, the pancreas makes little or no insulin, so sugar can't get into the body's cells for use as energy. People with Type 1 diabetes must use insulin injections to control their blood glucose.
